The Trauma Center at UAB is hosting the 13th Annual Trauma Symposium for nurses, ancillary health care providers, and pre-hospital care providers. This year we are excited to host the conference at a new location, Sheraton Birmingham Hotel on **Friday, March 12, 2010**.

The program is rich in clinically based topics covering all aspects of the care of injured patients. In addition to important didactic lectures, case presentations will be used to highlight a variety of topics including burn resuscitation, management of blunt aortic injuries, and basic x-ray interpretation. Directions to Sheraton Birmingham Hotel:

FROM I-65 NORTH OR SOUTH OR WEST I-20/I-59 TO HOTEL

Each of these interstates merges in downtown Birmingham. I-65 will merge onto I-20/I-59 East. Take first exit after the merge, which is 17th Street Exit. At first light take a left onto 8th Ave North. Go to 21st Street and make a left (21st Street is also Richard Arrington, Jr. Blvd North). You will go under Interstate 20/59 and you will see the BJCC and Hotel immediately ahead of you. To reach the BJCC/Medical Forum Parking Deck: Continue past the BJCC & Hotel, at the 1st red light take a right onto 22nd Street, one way, and the Medical Forum is directly ahead of you on the right with the BJCC parking deck on your left.

DIRECTIONS FROM I-20 EAST

Follow I-20, which will merge into I-20 and I-59. As you approach downtown, you will exit to the LEFT on the 22nd Street exit. Go straight to the light, which is 21st Street, take a right (21st Street is also Richard Arrington Jr. Blvd. North). The BJCC & Hotel are directly ahead of you. To reach the BJCC/Medical Forum Parking Deck: Continue past the BJCC & Hotel, at the 1st red light take a right onto 22nd Street, one way, and the Medical Forum is directly ahead of you on the right with the BJCC parking deck on your left.
